3 - 7	ESL/Citizenship	5-15	M-F Morning, M-F Evening, or Saturday Morning	This course focuses on the development of communicative English skills and knowledge of American History and Government for citizenship preparation. Instruction prepares students for the naturalization process including completion of the application for citizenship, preparation for the Citizenship History and Government test, and interactions needed for the final United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) interview.
3-7	ESL/Citizenship for Seniors (in Spanish)	5	M-F Afternoon M-F Evening	This citizenship class is designed for seniors (age 55+) who qualify to take the citizenship test in Spanish.

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
